Plus: coverage for medically necessary fertility preservation

what's covered

- Artificial Insemination (AI), Intrauterine Insemination (IUI), and Time Intercourse (TI) cycles
 - With or without stimulation with oral agents (e.g., clomiphene citrate, letrozole)
- Assisted Reproductive Technologies (ART)
 - Advanced reproductive technologies:
 - Monitoring of ovarian stimulation by ultrasound and related hormone assays
 - In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) Oocyte retrieval
 - Embryology services to include: oocyte identification, sperm identification, in vitro fertilization (IVF), Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI), embryo culture, embryo thaw, embryo preparation for transfer, embryo cryopreservation
- ART related services
 - Oocyte Thaw cycles and Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET) cycles (including use of donor eggs and donor embryos)
 - Oocyte cryopreservation cycles including one year of storage when a medical treatment will directly or indirectly lead to iatrogenic infertility (an impairment of fertility by surgery, radiation, chemotherapy, or other medical treatment affecting reproductive organs or processes including treatment related to gender affirmation)
 - Sperm cryopreservation including one year of storage when a medical treatment will directly or indirectly lead to iatrogenic infertility (an impairment of fertility by surgery, radiation, chemotherapy, or other medical treatment affecting reproductive organs or processes including treatment related to gender affirmation)
 - Embryo Biopsy for Preimplantation genetic testing (PGT, Preimplantation Genetic Diagnosis (PGD) and preimplantation Genetic Screening (PGS)
 - Oocyte from member that is age 35 or older
 - Recurrent Pregnancy Loss (three or more unexplained clinical pregnancy losses) or previously diagnosed aneuploid pregnancies or births
 - Both parents are carriers of a recessive single gene autosomal mutation
 - One parent is a known carrier of a single gene autosomal dominant or X-linked disease
 - One parent is a known translocation carrier
 - Storage of cryopreserved Embryos for up to one year beginning from the initial date of cryopreservation
- Infertility Specialty Medications Lifetime Maximum amount
 - Fertility specialty medications for the Eligible Covered Member for approved treatment cycles

adoption and surrogacy coverage

who is eligible

Eligible employees who intend to become the legal parent of a child adopted or born through surrogacy

what you get

\$15K combined lifetime maximum reimbursement toward eligible expenses related to adoption and surrogacy arrangements

what's covered

- Court costs, legal costs, and attorney's fees
- U.S.-based adoption and surrogacy agency fees
- Travel expenses for the Intended Parents or gestational carrier specifically related to the adoption or surrogacy occurrence
- Egg/sperm donation agency fees
- Fees charged by the surrogacy agency to administer the surrogacy occurrence
- Screening costs for gestational carrier and egg or sperm donor
- Expenses for adopting your step-child, your domestic partner's child, or your nephew, niece, cousin, brother, sister or grandchild

adoption and surrogacy coverage (CONT'D)
